T2202 Tuition and Enrolment Certificates

What is a T2202?

T2202 is a form issued by educational institutions to certify amounts that can be deducted for income tax purposes. It includes the number of months eligible for education and textbook credits. Previous to 2019, it was call T2202A.

Where do I get my T2202?

Full Time Programs:

Programs starting 2010 to present can be downloaded from: myvfs.com

Username - comprising of your class and first name (i.e. CA87John)

'Forgot your password?' - sends an email to the personal email address VFS has on file

Part Time Courses:

Eligible courses can be downloaded from: <https://ourvfs.com/connect/>

Student ID - found on payment receipt

Personal Email – external email address VFS has on file

Withdrew or dismissed from program?

Fill out the T2202 Request Form found under Alumni Services on the VFS website, and submit it to t2202@vfs.com email address.

*Tax records are only available for the previous 10 years.
This is following Canada Revenue Agency's guidelines.*



Frequently Asked Questions:

When will my latest T2202 be available to me?

Your latest T2202 will be available no later than February 28th of the following year (i.e. 2021 T2202 will be available by February 28th 2022).

I paid tuition this year but will not attend until the following year, do I get a T2202 this year?

No, you are only eligible to receive a T2202 for the year(s) you are in class. Deposits and/or tuition paid in prior calendar years will be included on your first eligible T2202.

I think I paid more money than what shows on my T2202, could it be wrong?

As VFS programs can span more than one calendar year, VFS is required to prorate tuition paid over the duration of your program (i.e. programs running from July 2018 to June 2019, would get approximately half of the program tuition on the 2018 T2202 and half on the 2019 T2202).

Are application fees included on my T2202?

Application fees are not included on the T2202; however, application fees are deductible for tax purposes as long as you enrol at VFS in the future.

I attended VFS in a prior year but made a payment in the current year, can I claim this?

Yes, you will have to contact VFS to have your T2202 amended for the year you attended.

I am an international student, why do I need a T2202?

VFS is required to issue a T2202 to all students to enable them to complete their Canadian income tax return. Please follow the guidelines set out by Revenue Canada to determine if you are required to file a Canadian tax return.

Can you explain how to file my taxes?
